BALLET

Classical Ballet Training provides the best foundation for technical training in all forms of dance. We encourage all students to take Ballet class to use as their base for all other classes, especially Jazz and Contemporary. UCD Ballet Students in terms 1 & 2 are dedicated to learning and working on their technique. We teach the very current and leading Australian Teachers of Dancing Classical Ballet Syllabus. Some of our Ballet Teachers are also trained in RAD (Royal Academy of Dancing).

In terms 3 & 4 our focus then moves towards refining our skills and preparing our concert routines. Routines include beautiful Classical Ballet and Lyrical Routines. Ballet is the foundation for developing good dance technique and prepares the dancers to develop beautiful strong bodies through the emphasis on good posture and the development of strength and flexibility.

Once students reach Silver Medal and above level, students are then required to attend twice a week. In 2022 we look forward to expanding our Ballet Extension Program.

Ballet is a Mainstream Class and students perform 2 routines at the end of year concerts.

POINTE

HIP HOP

Get funky with the very popular style for both girls and boys. Learn the freshest street moves like the ones on popular TV shows and Crews and traditional Hip Hop elements & styles.

Students learn Hip Hop technique and routines for fun and for performance. Students who wish to learn tricks are encouraged to take the Acro class along side of this.

Hip Hop is a Mainstream Class and students will perform 2 routines at the end of year concerts.

JAZZ

UCD keeps our Jazz Classes fun, fierce and fresh. Classes can include all styles of Jazz like you see on So You Think You Can Dance. Styles incorporate may include Commercial, Technical and Broadway Styles. Current up to date moves and songs are used.

Classes consist of a warm up, technical training, progressions such as turns, kicks and jumps and amazing routines. Terms 1 & 2 are dedicated towards focusing on technical training, while terms 3 & 4 moves towards concert routines.

Jazz is a Mainstream Class, students perform 2 routines at the end of year concerts. Those who do a Jazz/ Tap combo class perform 1 Jazz & 1 Tap routine.



TAP

Do you love making music, funky rhythms and beats? Tap is fun & energetic. Once you start you won't be able to keep your feet still.

Tap involves having special metal plates on the bottom of your shoes. UCD teaches the Australian Teachers of Dancing Syllabus in terms 1 & 2 and in terms 3 & 4 we then move onto preparing fun and funky Tap routines for the concert. We teach Traditional & Street Tap Technique.

Tap is a mainstream class, students perform 2 routines at the end of year concerts. Those who do Jazz/Tap combo classes perform 1 Jazz & 1 Tap routine.

CONTEMPORARY

A class for those who love to really show expression through dance. Lyrical based and dramatic routines are learnt. This class includes a warm up, flexibility work, technical combinations & floor work.

Students are encouraged to be taking Ballet classes alongside to assist student with technique.

Tween Contemporary students must be enrolled in Ballet to participate in this class, as ballet skills are required and are an ongoing necessity for technique in this class.

Senior & Open students, must be enrolled in Ballet, if not Jazz. Ballet is encouraged.

Contemporary is a Mainstream class, students perform 2 routines at the end of year concerts.

ACRO

The Focus is on dance tricks, partner skills, tumbling & limbering. Acro incorporates lots of strength, flexibility and conditioning which is vital to achieving, perfecting and advancing these skills. This class starts at the basics for new comers such as Bridges, rolls and Cartwheels and can lead towards more advanced skills in time and individual skill based, such as Splits, Jumps, Mounts, Cartwheels, Round Offs, Walkovers, Handstands, Side & Front Aerials and Back Saults.

Students commence by learning the proper fundamentals required to progress through this AcroDance level system. We NOW teach the Acrobatic Arts syllabus. In 2022 we aim to provide opportunities for students to complete optional exams to promote continuous progression.! ! Acro is a Mainstream class which perform 2 routines at the end of year concerts.

COMMERCIAL

Commercial dance refers to dancing performed in pop artist live shows, music videos and movies. It is a modern style of Dance that can incorporate a mix of genres and sub styles, in particular Jazz & Hip Hop.

Choreography is usually to Modern and Sassy Music. Commercial Dance is a fun, hard hitting style of Dance that is great for those who love the idea of film clip dancing, back up dancing in shows and especially good for those dancers looking at pursuing a career in the Dance Industry.

It is encouraged that students be taking Jazz & Hip Hop alongside this class to assist with the dynamics of this style.

Commercial is a Mainstream class, students perform 2 routines at the end of year concerts

MUSICAL THEATRE

Musical Theatre is a diverse and creative style of dance. It cannot really be defined as a particular dance style - rather it is a way of describing the choreography and movement associated with Broadway musicals. However, it is important to note that this dance style still requires a strong knowledge of dance technique.

Musical theatre also places a lot of importance on musicality and is intricately connected with the music, often the movement acting out or mimicking the lyrics. In Musical Theatre styles, students dance to the soundtracks of Broadway musicals, where it is the dancer's role to act out the story through movement. Some types of Musical Theatre Dance styles even involve singing the lyrics, acting or playing the part of a character.

Musical theatre dance is in many ways an essential element within Broadway musicals. Dance is often used to progress the storyline of the musical, alongside the singing and acting elements in productions. So, if you love to sing along to Broadway shows, or love to act out lyrics, Musical Theatre may be the style for you.

Musical Theatre is a Mainstream class, students perform 2 routines at the end of year concerts.
